Award-winning: DEUTZ apprentices score highly in final exams

Cologne, November 25, 2022 – The exceptional exam results of DEUTZ apprentices have been honored for the twelfth consecutive year. The Chamber of Industry and Commerce of Wuppertal, Remscheid, and Solingen (IHK) named Amelie Fanelsa as one of North Rhine-Westphalia’s best apprentices in the production mechanic examination.

The five apprentices include four production mechanics and an industrial electronics technician. The DEUTZ Factory for Talents’ Wall of Fame, where the award certificates for outstanding achievement received by DEUTZ apprentices are displayed, is rapidly filling up. Since 2011, the engine manufacturer’s trainees have received 41 local awards, 18 regional awards, and four awards at national level. DEUTZ has a long tradition of providing its own vocational training, having started to offer apprenticeships more than 100 years ago.
